## **Summer School Age Program**

**PARENT ORIENTATION:** Orientation for parent information regarding the Summer School Age Program, will be held at the Fox West YMCA, Wednesday May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at 6:30 p.m.

**REGISTRATION:** A \$30 non-refundable registration fee per child or \$50 non-refundable registration fee per family is required if you are new to the Fox West YMCA program. If you are currently enrolled in the 2011-2012 before/after care program and continue care into the summer, a \$10 renewal/per child fee will apply. *There is a minimum of 2 contracted days per week per child required.*

Open registration will begin Monday, January 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Fox West YMCA. No appointment is necessary to pick up the paperwork. Upon completion you will need to meet with Katie Fickel or Jean Gloudemans to hand the registration packet in. Your reservation WILL NOT be held or processed unless ALL of your child's enrollment paperwork is complete AND registration fee paid, NO EXCEPTIONS.

**FIELDTRIPS:** If your child is contracted on a fieldtrip day there will not be an additional fee. **Children attending a fieldtrip are required to wear a yellow color coordinated t-shirt for safety purposes.** Fieldtrip themed t-shirts are available for purchase. An order form is located in the packet to fill out and return with your payment of \$10.00 to the Child Care Office. Please make a separate check out from the registration fee.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation is contracted through local bus company for fieldtrips.

**PAYMENT POLICY:** Payments will be automatically deducted from a checking/savings account or credit card. Please fill out a Tuition Express form located in the registration packet. Your spot will NOT be secured until a payment plan is completed. If you have questions about billing/payments please call Jackie VandeVoort. The YMCA believes that no youth should be turned away due to the inability to pay. Financial assistance is available upon request. Also consider purchasing a youth membership for \$12 a month to qualify for the discounted rate.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** Schedule changes such as canceling, adding or switching days will be accepted until May 7<sup>th</sup>, with no charge. After this date, you are responsible for payment of ALL contracted days. Switching and adding days will incur a \$5 fee for **EACH** change. Full summer cancellation requires a two-week signed and dated written 'Program Termination Notification' Form. This form is available in the Child Care Office. Payment is in effect for the two weeks whether your child attends or not.

## Summer School Age Program

Summer School Age Care program offers diverse activities which promote the YMCA core values of Respect, Responsibility, Honesty and Caring.

**SITES:** The Fox West YMCA will offer our Summer Programs at the Fox West YMCA and Greenville Elementary.

**AGES:** Children ages 5 (must have completed 4K) through 5<sup>th</sup> Grade.

**AVAILABILITY:** Fox West YMCA and Greenville Elementary locations are available full days ONLY, Monday – Friday. Hours of operation are 6:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. There will be NO half day option. Program starts Monday, June 4<sup>th</sup> and continues through Thursday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012. A 2 day per week minimum per child is required.

**There will be NO Summer School Age Care Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup> and Friday, August 24<sup>th</sup>.**

**FEES:** Program fees include AM and PM snack and fieldtrip expenses.

### **WHAT TO BRING TO SCHOOL AGE SUMMER CARE:**

Everyday your child will need to have a water bottle, clearly labeled with their name. Please provide sun screen and bug repellent, clearly labeled with their name. These will be left at our facility for everyday use. **If it is a fieldtrip day, please check the fieldtrip form for other necessary items.** NO hand held video games, IPOD's/MP3 players, cell phones or toys. NO flip flops. Have your child wear Tennis Shoes or enclosed sandals.

**LUNCH:** Please send your child with a nutritious cold lunch everyday. Due to severe allergies in our program we have chosen to be a peanut free zone. **Please do not send any peanut products or anything that was processed with peanuts or tree nuts.**

### **SPECIAL SCHEDULED ACTIVITIES:**

Mondays – we will be offering the children a choice of 3 clubs, in which each child will pick one to attend. Clubs will be from 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. and will run for 3 weeks. Children/Teachers will then choose 3 different clubs for the next 3 weeks to participate in. (Clubs include choices such as Legos, Jedi, Cooking, etc.)

Tuesdays – designated swim days. Children will be going swimming in our pool from 1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. Please remember your child's swimming suit and towel.

Wednesdays – are our designated fieldtrip days. Please see the fieldtrip form for necessary items that your child may need.

Fridays – designated swim days. Children will be going swimming in our pool from 1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. Please remember your child's swimming suit and towel.

**FIELDTRIPS:** We have a great selection of locations this year. Some of these include Sunset Park, Heart of the Valley YMCA, Menominee Zoo/Park, Tri County Ice Arena and a few other fun ones. Fieldtrips are subject to change. Please see your fieldtrip form found in the packet. There will be no extra charge for fieldtrips.

**SPORTS CAMP / LESSON TRANSFER:** If a child is enrolled at the Fox West YMCA site, parents can sign their child up for sports camp, swim lesson, etc. The summer school age teachers will transfer the child to their class ONLY if the class/lesson is held at the Fox West YMCA location. Please fill out a 'Transfer Card.' If a sports camp is scheduled at the same time as a fieldtrip, children are required to go on the fieldtrip and miss their camp.

2. Fill out registration form completely.
3. Turn in registration form and \$25 non-refundable deposit (s) to the Fox West YMCA Member Services Desk for each week of camp registration per child.
4. Deposit(s) must accompany the registration form to complete registration. NO deposits will be refunded.
5. Must be members throughout the summer to receive member prices.
6. Registration and changes must be made at least 2 weeks prior to the beginning of the camp week.
7. Balance of camp fees must be paid on the Monday prior to the week of camp.
8. All cancellations must be made prior to May 7, 2011. After this date, deposits will not be moved nor applied to other camp balances.
