



17th Annual Neenah-Menasha YMCA Boys Basketball Tournament

6th and 7th Grade Teams on Saturday, March 17, 2012

General Information:

This tournament is designed to give youth the opportunity to play competitive basketball while having fun at the same time. This tournament will be a round-robin tournament. Teams will be broken into brackets within the age group and are guaranteed a minimum of three games. If a team drops out at the last minute, the tournament staff will try to find a team, but there may be an unforeseeable void. Proceeds will benefit the Neenah-Menasha YMCA Youth Programs.

YMCA Mission Statement:

Dates:

Registration Deadline is Friday, March 2, 2012 or as space is available. Registration will be a first come, first serve basis with payment. We will take between 8-12 teams per grade level depending on registration. Schedules will be mailed by March 7, 2012 to notify you of your first game. We will have two one day tournaments. First tournament games for 6th and 7th grade teams are on Saturday, March 17th at 8:30 a.m. First tournament games for 5th and 8th grade teams are Sunday, March 18th at 8:30 a.m. Championship games are tentatively scheduled for 5:30 p.m. on each day (subject to change).

Where:

The tournament will be held at the Menasha High School Fieldhouse, 420 Seventh Street, Menasha, WI, 54952.

Team & Fee Information:

Entry fee is \$150.00 first team, \$135 second team, \$125 for the third or more teams. If any team needs to drop out of the tournament after the entry deadline, the entry fee will not be refunded. Twelve individual trophies will be awarded to 1st & 2nd place in each grade. Individual medals will also be awarded to 3rd and 4th place in grade brackets that have a minimum of 12 teams. First Place will also receive a Championship T-shirt. Each team must have a minimum of 8 players and a coach, and a **maximum of 12 players on a roster**. Players must be on a roster in order to participate. A player may not be on more than one roster. Any games played with players not on the official roster will be forfeited. Rosters may be amended any time prior to the tip-off of the first game of the tournament. Once tip-off occurs NO more changes will be allowed for any reason. For all non-players, there will be an admission price. Everyone is welcome! \$3.00 Adults, \$2.00 Students, under 10 free. Concessions will be available. **No drinks allowed in the gym - including coaches and players (water is allowed on courts)**. Please pass this information to all spectators.

Tournament Rules:

Tournament Rules

The 17th Annual Neenah-Menasha YMCA Boys Basketball Tournament will follow WIAA High School Rules except the changes listed below.

1. Games will consist of two eighteen-minute halves. Clock will only stop for whistles during the last 2 minutes of each half, any injuries, and for all time outs. Overtime will be a three-minute period. Each team will receive two time-outs per half and an extra time-out for each overtime period. First half time-outs do not carryover to second half. Second half time-outs do carryover to the overtime(s). Only two overtimes will be allowed and then it's sudden death play, starting with a jump ball. The overtime periods will have a running clock for the first minute and will stop and start for whistles the last two minutes.
2. No pressing by 5th & 6th grade until the last two minutes of the each half. No pressing for any grade that has a **fifteen** point lead or greater.
3. 5th & 6th grades will use a regulation size women's basketball.
4. Two T's on any player or coach will be an automatic ejection. All technical fouls will result in an automatic two points and the ball out-of-bounds. If it is against a player, it will also count as a personal foul.
5. This is a YMCA sporting event and proper sportsmanship is expected from all participants, coaches, and fans. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Failure to comply may result in the forfeiting of the game and/or tournament.
6. Bonus on the 7th foul, double bonus on the 10th foul.
7. Teams must furnish their own matching shirts with numbers. They must also provide their own balls for warm-up.
8. Zone defenses will be allowed for all grades.
9. Pool tie-breaker:
 - I. Head-to-head competition.
 - II. Defensive Points Allowed.
 - III. Point Differential.
 - IV. Wild Card Team for Grade Brackets that have 10 or 12 teams only (Highest record of teams who didn't win division) will be determined **by fewest defensive points allowed then highest point differential (if needed)** will assume the #4 Seed.
10. **NO PROTESTS ALLOWED** - Officials decisions are final.
