## SUMMER PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Welcome to YMCA Summer School Age care. Whether you choose one week or all summer, YMCA School Age care fits your schedule and provides fun and enriching activities for your child. Having the highest quality leadership staff is our greatest asset. All staff are carefully selected and screened to ensure that YMCA Camp has the best possible role models for your children. All leadership staff participate in an intense training program and are CPR, First Aid and Child Safe certified. Because kids today need the camp experience more than ever, your child will have the opportunity to explore nature, discover new talents, gain independence, and build lasting relationships and memories. And of course, it's FUN! Thank you for choosing the Y!

**REGISTRATION:** Open registrations begin Monday, January 2 at 6:00am in the Appleton YMCA School Age Dept. or at CLC (CLC is for those registering to use that site only.) No early registrations will be accepted. No appointment is necessary. Reservations are done in person, on a first-come, first-served basis. Your reservation will not be held or processed unless all fees and enrollment paperwork is complete, no exceptions. A \$30 non-refundable registration fee per child is required if you are new to the summer program, \$50 family max. If you are currently enrolled in the 2011-12 before/after care or no school day program and continue care into the summer; a **\$10 renewal fee per child will apply.**

**PARENT ORIENTATION:** Appleton YMCA, Wednesday, June 6 at 6:30 pm for new families.

**AGES:** 5 - 12 years (Camp Shioc - all 5 year olds must have completed 5K kindergarten)

June 11 - August 31 Y/CLC/Camp Shioc

**No program Wednesday, July 4th, due to holiday or Friday, August 24th, due to all staff training**

**(\*\*Half day rates are for those children who attend a minimum 3-hour summer school or another YMCA sponsored program only.)**

**PAYMENT POLICY:** Payments are due the week prior to your child attending camp. Payments not receipted on Mondays, will be assessed a late fee by the Billing Department. All fees will be deducted automatically by either debit/credit card or checking/savings account. The YMCA believes that no youth should be turned away due to the inability to pay. Financial assistance is available upon request. W2 state and county funding also accepted. Consider purchasing a youth membership for \$12 a month to qualify for the discounted rate. If you need to make payment arrangements, please call 920-954-7646.

**CANCELLATION/TERMINATION POLICY:** Cancellations/deletion of days will be accepted until Monday, May 7 with no charge. After this date the full contracted rates will apply. Terminations for the full or remainder of summer days require a two-week written notification: schoolage@ymcafoxcities.org. The full contracted rates are in effect for the two-week period. (CLC terminations must go through cnodolf@ymcafoxcities.org)

**SCHEDULE CHANGES:** Schedule changes/switching of days will only be accepted until Monday, May 7. Contracted days as of May 7 will be charged out in full unless a program termination notification is given per the policy above.

**MEALS/SNACKS:** School Age care participants at the Y and school site locations must provide daily lunch; program will provide am/pm snacks. CLC offers a pre-pay lunch option. Camp Shioc participants must provide daily am/pm snacks and lunch. Milk will be provided for lunch at all site locations.

**FIELDTRIPS:** Fieldtrips must be contracted as a full day. Children attending a fieldtrip are required to wear a color coordinated t-shirt for safety purposes. Fieldtrip t-shirts are available for purchase in the School Age Office for \$10.00. (order form enclosed). If you attended summer care in 2011, you may reuse same shirt. **Please note:** staff do not stay back on fieldtrip days due to summer school participation, please schedule accordingly by attending our fieldtrip or using an alternative site selection after summer school is dismissed. Transportation not included.

**TRANSPORTATION:** The Y has contracted Lamers Bus Company for fieldtrips, swim times and Camp Shioc.

**SWIM LESSONS:** Swim lessons will be offered on a weekly basis at the Appleton Y. A separate registration will be required. Fees include weekly lesson and transportation. Transportation from Camp Shioc is not available. If you wish to participate, please select an applicable site.

## CAMP SHIOC

The Appleton YMCA maintains ten beautiful acres twenty miles northwest of Appleton where kids can enjoy fishing, paddle boating and canoeing on our stocked fishing pond. They also have the opportunity to try our archery range (must be 7 yrs. old to participate in archery), sports field and playground area along with an outdoor amphitheater for skits and plays. Camp Shioc is a fully enclosed compound, which also includes a complete infrastructure of eating facilities and lavatories.
